Supplies Needed:

- §§ Sewing machine in working order with the ability to drop the feed dogs
- §§ Walking foot, free motion foot
- §§ Knee lift if available for your machine
- §§ Top stitch needle size 90/14
- §§ Scissors
- §§ 2 sets of thread light and dark with matching bobbins of Polyester type
- §§ Gel Pens or pencils of different colors
- §§ Quilting gloves or Vaseline type hand cream
- §§ Chalk, or blue pen for marking items
- §§ Ruler, at least 11 inches long
- §§ Bring your unfinished tops for discussion!!

Fabric Needed for Class:

- §§ Pin together 4 sandwiches of plain fabric (no pattern, fat quarter size) with cotton batting size, shop the bargain bin!
- §§ When you pin the sandwiches together, pin a fist apart, no fusing please.

Items included with your class fee:

- § Quilt sandwiches of a 9 patch and applique block
- § Drawing pad
- § Mini booklet of class notes
